Commonwealth Government funded support for older people with complex care needs to live independently in their own homes.

Transition Care Program

A care program designed to improve older people's independence and confidence after a hospital stay. Transition care can be provided within the hospital setting or in the client's own home.

Youth Assist Clinic

Free clinic to support young people aged 12-25 years with physical, mental and sexual health concerns. The clinic has a Nurse, GP and headspace counsellor onsite

About Community Care

South Gippsland Hospital's Community Care provides a range of allied health, nursing and support services to the Corner Inlet Community.

Our experienced healthcare providers work with each client to create a person-centred plan to deliver individualised care.

We also host a range of other services provided by external practitioners. These can be found on our website or by calling the Community Health Centre.

Community Care Services

Day Respite Service

Centre-based day respite services in a comfortable home-like environment providing support for clients and their carers.

Diabetes Education

Education and support for adults with Type 1 and Types 2 Diabetes Mellitus and Gestational Diabetes.

District Nursing Service

A home-based nursing service providing care in the community 7 days-a-week and centre-based care for wound assessment and treatment.

Exercise Physiology

Individual assessment, group rehabilitation and exercise classes (Moovers) to improve fitness, mobility, balance and strength.

Falls and Balance Group

An 8-week program tailored to client needs by identifying individual's falls risks and safety strategies.



McGrath Cancer Care Nurse (Breast)

Specialist nursing care providing individual and family support, referral, information and resources at any stage of breast cancer.

Mental Health Counselling

Free mental health counselling for a range of mild to moderate conditions. No referral necessary from a GP.

Nursing Foot Care Clinic

Basic foot and nail care for seniors provided by an Enrolled Nurse. Requires assessment and referral from a podiatrist to access the service.

Occupational Therapy

Functional assessment, education, practical advice and equipment prescription to enable people to manage independently within their home and community.

Physiotherapy

Assessment of mobility/movement and advice/treatment to restore physical function when someone is affected by injury, illness or disability.

Positive Ageing Service

Support to improve health and wellbeing by assisting with providing support to clients to access exercise, diet, social connection, grief, loss, loneliness, navigating health and community services and managing digital technology.

Sexual Reproductive Health Clinic

Cervical screening, breast awareness and education and information on all aspects of reproductive health from puberty to post menopause.

Social Support Group

Centre and community-based activities providing an opportunity for clients aged over 65yrs to meet new people, learn new hobbies, visit local attractions and share a meal.



Social Work

Assisting people to overcome difficulties in their life by providing resources, counselling and advice to complete applications and access further support.

Stomal Therapy

Nursing care for people with a stoma or fistula including pre and post-op counselling, ongoing education and review and advice on continence and bowel health.
